Facilities for a range of indoor and outdoor sports should be provided within the scheme.


Summary of position

The proposals include formal and informal sports, recreation and leisure opportunities.

The central sports hub includes grass and artificial pitches for formal sport participation (e.g. football, rugby, hockey and cricket).

The wider green space and parks incorporate running routes, outdoor gym / trim trail equipment, informal sports participation, play areas and cycleways.

The Indoor Sports Hall and Community Building will offer badminton and other court sports. Sports facilities provided at the schools will be available for Community Use and there is an opportunity for a commercial gym within the District Centre.





Your feedback

Dog walking and exercising areas should be provided in open spaces.

The landscaping should include native species; additional trees; retention and strengthening of some of the existing landscaping; and the creation of new water features, wildlife pools and habitat areas.

Summary of position

The scheme includes a variety of on-street and off-street dog walking routes throughout the site and to the wider area. The open spaces include areas where dogs can be exercised away from vehicular traffic.

Native species, or varieties, will be planted in the network of green spaces, including structural woodland planting, significant new tree planting and new hedgerows to supplement the retained landscape features.

The design incorporates a variety of new habitats and will achieve biodiversity net gain that exceeds current Council policy requirements.
